# Master Plan Overview

- 20-year plan to safely and efficiently meet aviation demand at an airport
- Began in July of 2021
- Kickoff meeting in August 2021
- Forecast and Facility
   Requirements Open House in October 2022
- Normally a two-year process







# Commercial Forecast

- Passenger enplanements to grow 1.9% annually
- Airline operations to grow 1% annually
- Critical Aircraft Airbus A319/320







### Air Cargo Forecast

- Cargo movement to grow 3.9% annually
- Cargo operations to grow 2.3% annually
- Critical Aircraft ATR 72







### General Aviation Forecast

- GA operations to grow 0.8% annually
- Military operations to grow 2.1% annually
- Based aircraft to grow 1.3% annually
- GA Critical Aircraft Challenger 300

#### Requirements Airfield

Relocate Runway 3 windcone outside RSA

Expand runway shoulders and blast pads

Expand taxiway width and shoulders

For Eliminate direct access to Runway 17/35 from apron

Relocate the deicing pad and VOR-DME

Reconfigure GA parking spaces

Add 41 hangars





### Requirements Landside

Expand the terminal and add 2 gates

 Expand all parking lots – passenger, employee, rental car

Expand the cargo apron and processing facility

Expand the SRE building

Expand the terminal access road





# Recommended



### Recommendations

- Add approach lights to Runway 3
- Assess storm drainage capacity and structural integrity
- Reconfigure parking lot access point along Skyline
- Add EV charging stations to the parking lots

### Master Plan Next Steps

- Allow 30 days for additional public comment (March 1, 2024)
- City/Airport selects the preferred alternatives







### Master Plan Next Steps

- Develop an implementation plan and complete the ALP
- Hold a TAC/public open house to present the draft Master Plan/ALP
- Allow for public comment then finalize the Master Plan and ALP
- Submit to FAA for review and comment
- Incorporate FAA comments, then submit to City Council for adoption
